General cargo is handled by cranes on the quay, floating cranes or by the ship's own cargo gear (deck cranes, derricks, etc.). Attached to such lifting gear is a shackle which links the crane or derrick with the form of cargo-handling equipment being used. For most lifts a hook is used.

### CARGO-HANDLING EQUIPMENT ON BOARD AND IN PORT

The cargo handling equipment used for ship during cargo operations are gantry cranes on the pier. Gantry cranes are especially used for container handling. These cranes are fitted with spreaders that can be adjusted for twenty foot, forty foot and forty-five foot containers. Some of them can also be adjusted for twin lift.

18 Cargo handling equipment that is lifted onto or off ships by crane or derrick should be provided with suitable points for the attachment of lifting gear, so designed as to be safe in use. The equipment should also be marked with its own gross weight and safe working load.

### Lifting Operations Onboard Ship

With RoRo, there's less lifting. By only touching the handling equipment when the cargo is gently rolled on and positioned onboard, the risk of damage is minimal compared to lifting units onto or off a vessel. Even when transshipment is involved, cargo can remain on the same equipment. Since cargo is stowed on enclosed decks, it is sheltered from the elements, reducing the need for packaging.

The existing regulation sets in-use requirements for diesel cargo handling equipment at ports and rail yards, including but not limited to: yard trucks (hostlers), rubber-tired gantry cranes, container handlers, and forklifts. General cargo ship deck crane : A large number of ships are fitted with deck cranes. These require less time to prepare for working cargo than derricks and have the advantage of being able to accurately place (or spot) cargo in the hold.

Tankers are fitted with pumping systems and pumps, with small cranes to handle hoses from shore, and with tankcleaning machines and inert-gas generating systems.
